Consumer Council's New Diesel Price Calculator Helps Drivers Shop Smart

Consumer Council is committed to providing the latest information on auto-fuel prices and helping drivers budget for the expense. Following the “oil price calculator” launched in 2012, today the Council has launched the “diesel price calculator”, which enables drivers shop smartly by getting the latest information on diesel price anywhere, anytime.

The “diesel price calculator” offers daily updates on the prices and discounts on diesel fuel by different oil companies including Esso, Caltex, Shell, Petrochina and Sinopec. The app features a positioning system which enables drivers to search the location of and distance to the nearest fuel station. Drivers can also know via the app the services available in a particular station such as car wash, auto beauty or has any toilet facilities.

The app can also alert users by means of “push notification” such as the change in diesel fuel prices. It allows consumers to create up to three personal cards and input each refill for fuel expense monitoring and usage estimation. Consumer can also choose the fuel station that offers the best bargain in regard to the latest discounts and promotions provided by fuel stations.

It can also serve as a one-stop interface enabling consumers to keep record of membership card bonus points, card benefits, payment records and previously search locations.
